Give her a backpack that stands out from a sea of nylon and has Southwestern flair to boot.

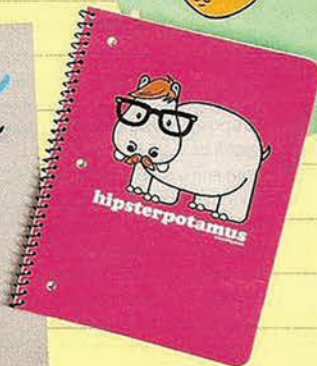
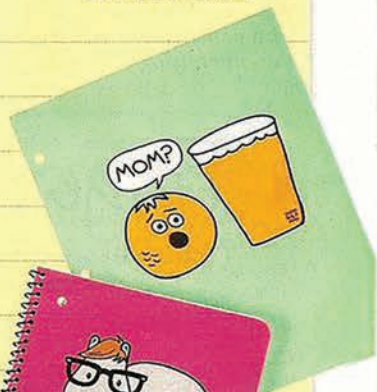
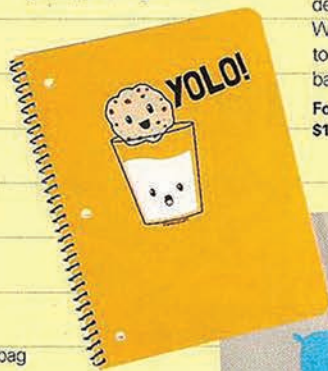
